FAO Rome and Honduras share progress on the PCFSy Project and Right to Food

Last March 4, 2025, the Right to Food Team from FAO Rome and Honduras organized a Zoom meeting to share key progress on the PCFSy Project. The meeting highlighted the initiative's contributions to the development of the new Human Rights Policy, most especially its integration of the Right to Food.

During the meeting, the FAO team gained deeper insight into the project's impact, including how it has strengthened collaboration with government institutions and agencies. FAO expressed interest in continued partnership, inviting the team to upcoming activities to further align initiatives promoting rights-based food systems.

Raul Pinel, PCFSy Project Coordinator from Rikolto, emphasized, "These two projects are complementary, and it is crucial to focus on the vulnerable groups that can be impacted as rights holders. The key element is ensuring that these policies move from theory to practice so that citizens can experience their effects in everyday life, particularly in the pursuit of the right to food."
