



NEWS REPORT: IIRR CAMBODIA

Keo Seima REDD+ Project Planning Workshop

From June 26 to 27, 2025, as project partner, IIRR contributed inputs during Keo Seima's consultation workshop as they prepare for their 2026 Activity Plan.

The workshop brought together 233 participants, including 56 women, representing indigenous community members, local authorities, youth, and civil society actors. Discussions were centered on livelihood improvement through climate smart agricultural technical training, health awareness, social enterprise

The planning workshop was under the Keo Seima Wildlife Sanctuary, Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation (REDD+) Project — which strongly resonates with IIRR's ongoing work in the Mondulkiri province. The project actively involves indigenous people in information and knowledge dissemination, in alignment with the United National Declaration of Right of Indigenous People (UNDRIP), Voluntary Guidelines on Right to Land Tenure (VGGT), Voluntary Guidelines on Food Systems and Nutrition (VGFSyN) and the Right to Food (VGRtF).
